Applicant should:

- hold at least Ph.D. degree in field of social sciences in *economics and finance* or *management and quality sciences* or in field of economic sciences in *economics* or *finance* or *management sciences*;
- have documented scientific achievements in the issues of: *use of quantitative methods in economics and finance* or/and *use of quantitative methods in management* or/and *business process modelling*;
- have the potential and readiness for further scientific development and conducting research in the declared scientific discipline;
- have professional qualifications at the academic level to teach university students;
- have predispositions to scientific work and teaching, show self-discipline, creativity and independence at work;
- have command of the English language at the level necessary for studying scientific literature, editing scientific papers and teaching;
- have command of the Polish language necessary for teaching.

The candidate should be prepared to teach courses in: statistics, econometrics, econometrics and forecasting of economic processes, operations research, business process modelling.
